RECENT ACTIVITY

Development Application approved

Albemarle's application to build a temporary workers' accommodation off Taranto Road has been approved by the Joint Development Assessment Panel. This means, provided we can address a range of conditions, we have the planning approval required to proceed with the project.

We welcome this news as the village is a key enabler of our ongoing investment in the Kemerton Lithium Plant which will contribute significantly to our region including providing many business opportunities and hundreds of new construction and operations jobs.

Importantly a village accommodation solution also ensures the health and wellbeing of the workforce is better managed, while local rentals and tourist facilities remain available and affordable.

Address approval conditions

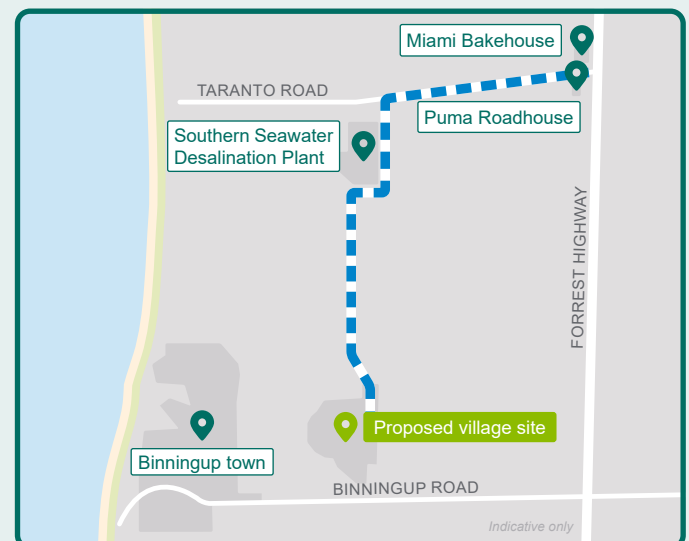
For now, we're working to address the various approval conditions set by the Joint Development Assessment Panel. These include developing Social Impact and Operational Management Plans.

ABOUT THE PROJECT

Albemarle is proposing to build a 500-person high-quality temporary workers accommodation village off Taranto Road. The facility will provide essential accommodation to construction workers needed for future expansion of the Kemerton Lithium Plant. Designed to fit within the landscape, on a small portion of the proposed site, the village will only be accessible to traffic via Taranto Road, with shuttle buses taking workers to and from site.
